Dear Cllr Roberts,

I have responsibility for overseeing mayoral and TfL policy on cycling. On 7 March the Mayor, Sir Peter Hendy and I launched our vision for cycling, promising greatly increased spending.


Much of this increased funding will be paid to boroughs. I hope that Greenwich can be among them. We have a number of exciting projects which I would like to discuss with you, including our possible Superhighway, CS4, through the borough, other new routes, and the possibility of a new bike superhub at North Greenwich or Abbey Wood stations, with a network of connecting routes, to serve the Greenwich Peninsula or Thamesmead.

In the next few weeks, we will be drawing up our LIP funding guidance for 2014/15. I am therefore keen to meet you and your officers in order to gauge whether the council wishes to proceed with any of these schemes, or to avail itself of any TfL and mayoral funds for cycling in the future.

Perhaps your office could get in touch with my PA, [REDACTED], on [REDACTED], to arrange a mutually convenient time. I can, of course, come to Woolwich.

May I reiterate that I am extremely keen to fund cycling projects in the Royal Borough of Greenwich, and to work with the council. I look forward to hearing from you.
